Gettysburg is getting ready for us and we can anticipate a great time. **The Wyndam Gettysburg is our Reunion Headquarters hotel, 95 Presidential Circle, Gettysburg, PA 17325, located on the junction of Highways**

15 and 30 (York Road). Call 866-845-8885 to set your reservations. Refer to 2/1 CAVALRY ASSOCIATION for the block of rooms for the \$104 (plus tax) room rate. If you wish to register online there will be a hotel online registration link on our 2/1Cav website. We have three days before and three days after the reunion at the same room rate so you can take in the surrounding areas.

Our reunion schedule is forming up and it will be something like this:

- **Thursday, 16 August**, will be Registration Day where you'll receive your paperwork and have the rest of the afternoon to spend visiting in the Hospitality Room or go see the sights around Gettysburg. Please bring a picture of yourself/spouse from the "Old Days" to put on the name tags! Troop Meetings and Association Business meeting and the Ladies Social will be that evening.
- **Friday, 17 August**, 10 a.m. will be our Memorial Service on the hotel patio where we'll have chairs or move inside for inclement weather. The afternoon is free to visit or tour.
- **Saturday, 18 August**, is an open day until the Banquet. We will be visiting the Gettysburg Battle Field and possibly Pickets Charge (*there will not be busses*). If you would like to participate in the charge, you need to sign up and please bring your state flag to carry. The Banquet Happy Hour starts at six and will let us relax and find our seats before the raffle and silent auction begins.
- All too quickly it will be Sunday and it will be our 9 a.m. farewell meeting and checkout.

Please reserve your place at the Reunion and Hotel prior to 27 July 2012 as that is the cutoff date for \$104. Fill out the enclosed reunion registration form and send it in before you lay it aside and forget.

SIT-REP BY-LAWS CHANGE:

The By-Laws Committee has reviewed our Association By-Laws amended on 05 September 2006; replacing the original document approved 02 September 2000. The reasoning behind the review was that although the 2006 amendment opened the Association membership up to all who served with the 2/1 CAV prior to and after Viet Nam, those memberships did not develop. It was thought that it was time to “return to our roots”. Our current By-Laws are on the 2/1 CAV website to compare to the proposed changes which are:

- **Front Cover:** Proposed changes *submitted* to membership at the 2012 Reunion.
- **Page 1, C:** The term “Active Class Members” means those persons who honorably served in the 2nd Squadron, 1st (Armored) Cavalry in Vietnam.
- **Page 1, D:** The term “Associate Class Members” means those persons that wish to support the Corporation and participate in its activities, including family, friends or *other persons who are selected for membership by a majority of Active members present.*
- **Page 13, Article XI, Approval:** Active Class Members of the Corporation on the *day of approval 2012.*

These amendments will be presented and voted on in Gettysburg during our business meeting. Please review these changes and refer to the standing By-Laws located on the 2/1 CAV website: www.2-1cavalry.com.

SAVANNAH – John D. Butcho – Flight Class 68-9, Cobra transition Class 69-2, Flew in Vietnam with Troop D, 2nd Squadron, 1st Calvary. CW2 John D. Butcho of Savannah, Georgia, passed away on Monday, November 14, 2011, after a twenty year battle with a cancerous brain tumor. John received the Distinguished Flying Cross for heroism on Aug 1, 1969, while supporting a Long Range Patrol which was surrounded by a numerically superior enemy force. His other awards include the Bronze Star, Air Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal, Army Aviator Badge, National defense Service Medal and the Marksman Badge. Flying, and anything related to it, was his passion. He continued to fly privately into the 1990s.

I. THE PRESIDENTIAL UNIT CITATION (ARMY). Award of the Presidential Unit Citation (Army) by the President of the United States of America to the following units of the Armed Forces of the United States is confirmed in accordance with paragraph 104, AR 673-5-1. The text of the citation, signed by President Richard Nixon on 5 May 1971, reads as follows:
