TEICHEIRA, George Wayne Passed away in Ft. Bragg, CA on March 17, 2018. A craftsman, carpenter, storyteller, Vietnam Veteran, sailor, artisan, athlete, outdoorsman, comedian, friend and father. He loved the ocean, his son, his friends and his tools of his various trades. He loved Dali, Gaudi, Mel Brooks, David Bromberg, Bob Dylan, Stevie Ray Vaughn, the Stones, westerns, the SF Giants-Warriors-49ers, comics, history and architecture. He delighted in dominos, cards, backgammon and the NYT Crossword, which he did every morning. Born in Eureka, CA in 1945, he grew up in Ukiah with his parents, Manuel and Barbara, and sister Janice, before moving to Ft. Bragg, graduating from Ft. Bragg HS in 1963. He attended SR Junior College before being drafted into combat service for the US Army. After his honorable discharge, he thrived in the North Bay, and returned to Ft. Bragg in 2005 to spend the rest of his days. George is survived and loved by his son, Alex, and his loyal friends. Of his many quotes, one from "Support your Local Sheriff" stands out: "Basically, I'm on my way to Australia." A private ceremony will be held celebrating his life Saturday, March 31 in Ft.
